



## OUTCOMES: 2010-2011

- **Over 300 prisoners** received educational programs this year.
- **90% of AWE's 140 core participants**, who completed meditation and behavioral change courses, remain free of violence and all behavioral violations.
- **85% of core participants engaged in service or outreach** to fellow prisoners, victims of crime, and/or local communities in need.
- **5 of 7** who qualified to take the GED test, passed it; 12 others showed progress and await test results.
- **Of 11 GED graduates remaining at Potosi**, 9 remain free of violence and other violations.
- **Continuing Ed courses grew four-fold** to include Ethics, Introduction to Psychology, Communication Skills, and Managing Conflict. 67 prisoners benefitted. 94% remain violation-free.
- **Art program expanded** to two jails; 69 prisoners benefitted.
- **91% of 35 ex-offenders** who were released remain free of recidivism.
